**Our community will vote on a Brandywine Community Schools bond proposal on May 7, 2024. If approved, this proposal would provide approximately \$22 million for district-wide improvements, with an expected zero mill increase. District infrastructure improvements would address safety and security, career and technical education, building envelope improvements, educational space, sitework and parking, and athletics.**



## THE 2024 BOND PROPOSAL FOCUSES ON

### CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

- New dedicated space for CTE programs
- ADA compliant space to accommodate growing needs

### OUTDOOR INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS

- Parking lot repaving at the middle school/high school campus
- Parking lot expansion for CTE/auto shop

### EXTRACURRICULAR/ATHLETICS

- Running track resurfacing
- New baseball field (ADA compliant)
- Repurposed CTE space for overflow athletic program

### LEARNING ENVIRONMENT IMPROVEMENTS

- New Performing Arts Center
- Creating dedicated cafeteria and gymnasium space at Merritt Elementary
- Create safe and secured entries & vestibules

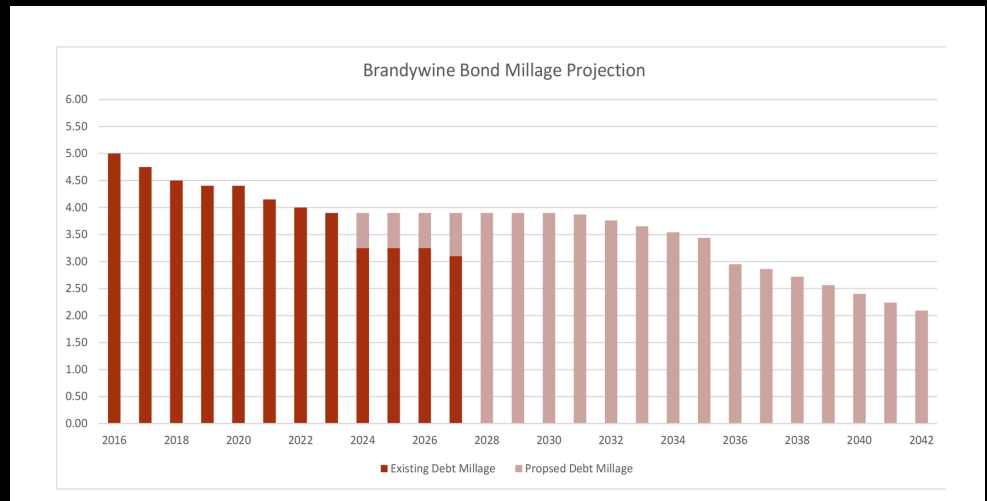
